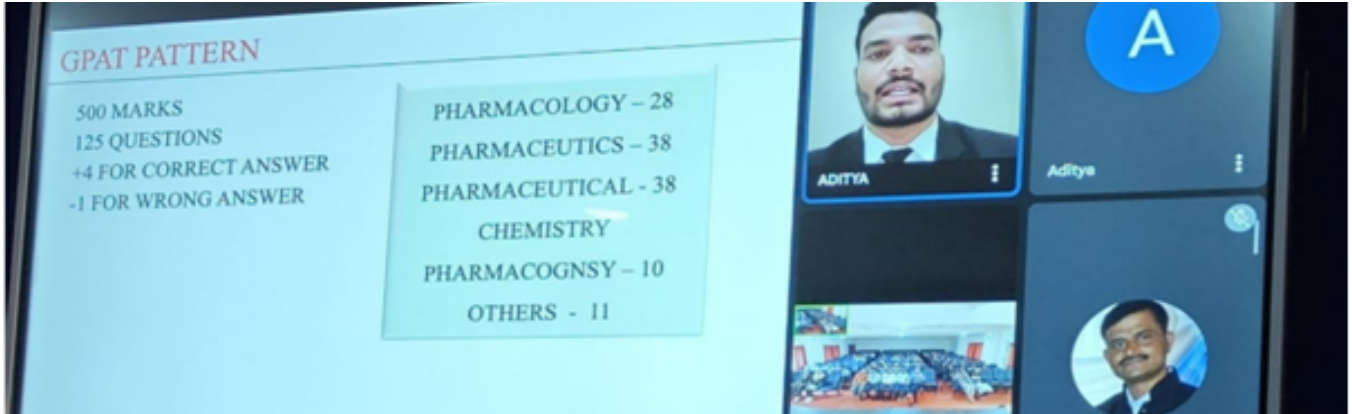

Joy of Giving: Orphanage Visit to Sadashanti on a Special Birthday Occasion

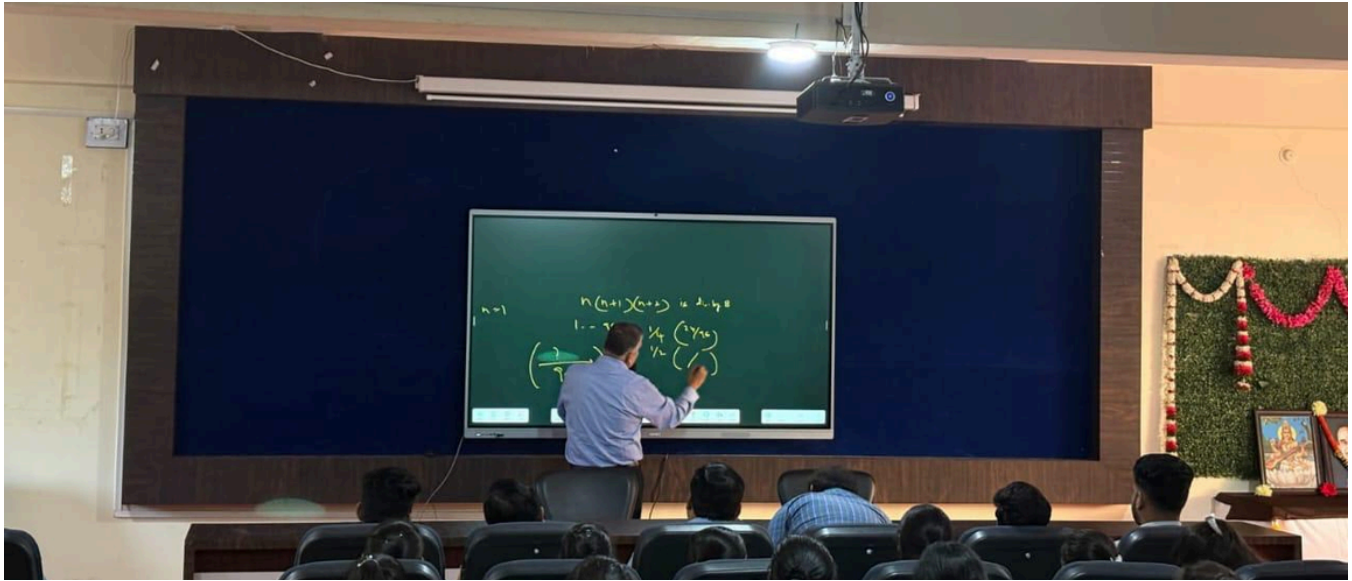


Honouring Hon'ble Ms. Tanvi Yogendraji Gode Madam's Birthday

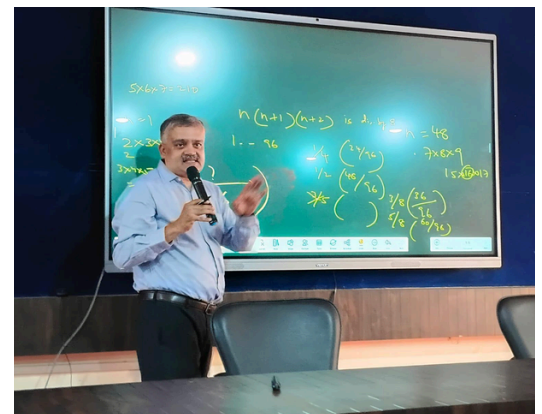


Think, Analyze, Succeed: A Seminar on Reasoning & Aptitude

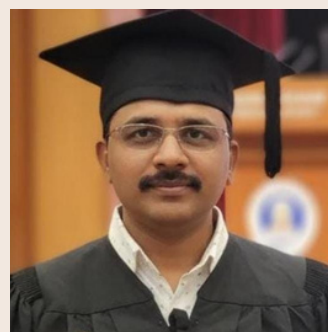

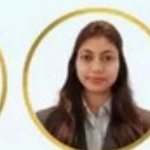

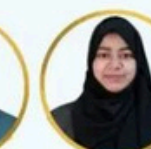
